TRENDING DESTINATIONS AMONGST INDIAN STUDENTS- 2024



More Indian students are going to Germany for their higher education paving way to Germany's labour market amidst severe labour shortage.

- With close to 50000 Indian students currently studying in Germany, India has surpassed China becoming the biggest source market for international students.
- → Students prefer variety of courses indicating the wide range of English taught degrees available at German universities. Based on a report, 60% Indian students are studying Engineering, 21% are pursuing Law, Management and Social Studies, 13% are studying Mathematics & Natural Sciences while 5% go for Humanities, Agriculture & other courses.
- → Most higher education institutions in Germany teach German along with degree studies to train international students better.
- → With severe shortage of labour in Germany, Indian students not only benefit from the excellent quality of education and knowledge of German language but also find it easier to enter the labour market upon completion of studies. (Indian IT Professionals are preferred in Germany.)
- Germany is best known for offering quality education in an affordable budget specially for those who come from low-medium income backgrounds with decent grades making the dream of international education possible.




Yet another year of maximum Indian students flying to the USA for their higher education and its beyond STEM.

- → In 2023, more than 1,40,000 Indian students were granted a student visa to the USA.
- → In 2O24, the number of visa grants to Indian students for the USA are expected to hit an all-time high number.
- → 76% of the students from India go for STEM courses while more and more are enquiring for non-STEM courses as well specially in Social Sciences, Public Policy, Counselling and Teaching.
- More universities are emphasizing on including 'real work experiences' than traditional tests making it more attractive.
- → Safety is paramount and USA universities assure of having their own safety and security plans in place. At the same time, they expect students to reach out to the university officials and understand the provisions in place upon arrival for a smoother transition.
