


Canada Announced Updates on Post Study Work Visa Rules

→ University graduates will be eligible for up to 3 years of Post Study Work Permit while graduates from colleges will be eligible for a 3-year long PGWP if it falls in an area under high labour market demand list.

Australia's Capping Announcement,What Does it Mean for Students?

- → Australian government has announced the much-awaited information on capping of international students in 2O25.
- → Good News! Capping doesn't mean decreased seats but, a better division of available seats across higher education institutions (HEIs).
- → Under the new capping on enrolment numbers, some sought-after HEIs now have more seats for international students.
- → This is a positive news as it would mean diverse class formation, enhanced learning experience and a better chance of getting accepted, all leading to desired graduate outcomes.






The UK Visa Financial Requirements: International Students will have to show increased funds for living expenses

- → 2nd January 2025 onwards, below would be applicable.
 - London: GBP1483 * 9 = GBP13347
 - Outside London: GBP1136 * 9 = GBP10224
- → Important Update: November 2024 intake is still open in the UK so it is the last chance for students aspiring to enrol at a British university in 2024 and save up to 2 Lacs on living expense plus get more time to work during breaks and support the living.
